

Sixth Form Wireless Agreement

By connecting to Guilsborough School's sixth form wireless network you will agree to the following terms and conditions.

- That you have fully licensed any operating systems and software that you have installed on your laptop
- Access to the Internet is granted for curriculum studies only (no games, music downloads, etc)
- Each laptop must pass school's health and safety tests and be available for inspection at all times
- You will not unplug any other equipment from a power socket in order to power your laptop
- The school accepts no responsibility for any damage caused to your laptop
- The school will not support your laptop software, and will not diagnose / fix problems that are not directly related to the connection to the schools wireless network
- Your laptop must be running Microsoft Windows XP, no other operating systems will supported by the network
- You will keep your laptop up to date with regular Microsoft Windows Updates (no support is given for this)
- You will be running suitable up to date virus software (the school may help with this at its own discretion)
- The standard Computer Use Policy still applies
- No other person will use your laptop when it is connected to the school network
- There is a small fee of £5 to cover additional costs of printer maintenance and toners, this should be paid to the Head of Sixth Form

If the school feels that any of the terms and conditions have been broken, access will be indefinitely removed from the student.

The System Manager also reserves the right to remove access from a student at anytime without explanation (the service is offered as a privilege not a right).

This agreement will need to be renewed every 12 months.
